ACLI ANNUAL CONFERENCE 2022 HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

ACLI continues to monitor the situation related to [Coronavirus \(COVID-19\)](#) to ensure the safety and security of attendees at our conferences. We are working closely with the JW Marriott Washington, D.C. to ensure that best practices are in place throughout every step of our meeting.

As of **March 17, 2022**, CONFERENCE GUIDELINES FOR ACLI ANNUAL CONFERENCE 2022 ATTENDEES ARE AS FOLLOWS*:

- All participants **must be fully vaccinated** and are required to **provide proof of vaccination OR provide a negative COVID test**** within 72 hours of travel to the conference. ***Test to be arranged by attendee. Rapid (antigen), PCR tests, and at-home tests are all accepted.*
- If you believe you are experiencing symptoms, in advance of travel, no matter how mild, it is strongly recommended that you do not attend.

 - *If you need to cancel your hotel reservation*, please contact reservations at 202-393-2000 within 24 hours of your reservation to receive a refund minus the processing fee.
